Please accept this letter of reference, which I have written on behalf of my former teacher, Andrée Amarica.

Andrée taught two colleagues and me French twice per week for roughly three hours per day from approximately early January until the end of March this year. During that time, I found her to be an excellent French teacher.

Not only was Andrée diligent, patient and pleasant to work with, but she was always very well-prepared for class. Best of all, at least from my perspective, she showed tremendous enthusiasm for the job.

Whereas I have had some teachers before who have tended to spend all their time handing out and collecting grammar exercises, and whereas I've experienced others who have sometimes turned their classes into free-for-alls where little of substance was accomplished, I got the sense with Andrée that there was always a plan, that she was always leading us towards greater understanding of the French language. I found her lessons to be varied enough to remain interesting, with just the right amount of review to help solidify the concepts we were studying.

After our regular classes ended, I hired Andrée to tutor me for two private lessons prior to a French language speaking exam. I believe the tutorials, plus the regular winter and spring lessons were major factors in helping me to achieve my "C" level — which is the second-highest grade one can achieve on that test.

I have absolutely no reservations whatsoever about recommending Andrée to other students and wish her all the best in her future endeavours.
